Supervision is required in the week before you work with a child. If you do not receive supervision in the preceding week, you are not eligible to be paid at the TSS service rate in the following week (the pay rate is the prevailing minimum wage). You need 1 hour of supervision if you expect to work 20 or more hours with a child in the following week. You need ½ hour of supervision if you expect to work under 20 hours in the coming week.

If you are unable to receive supervision by 6:00 pm on Friday, you can call our emergency supervision line to receive supervision by telephone from a Masters-level Mental Health Professional. This should happen only on **rare** occasions.
